

ISA Student Scholarship Application

Check the scholarship(s) you are applying for:

- The Carolyn Affleck Memorial Scholarship:** (any instrument) Carolyn Affleck was a dedicated and beloved Suzuki violin teacher for many years in the Treasure Valley. Three of her eight children studied the Suzuki Method on piano, violin and cello. In her memory, the Affleck family will award two \$250 scholarships toward tuition to the Idaho Suzuki Institute. Preference will be given to families who have more than one person attending Institute (as a teacher trainee or a student), and those who will be unable to attend without financial assistance.
- The Susan Bauman Memorial Scholarship:** (violin) It is the intention of the Idaho Suzuki Association that dividends (\$250) accruing from investment of Susan Bauman's memorial gifts be used for scholarship grants to broaden the musical experiences of Idaho Suzuki Institute violin students by allowing them to attend other Suzuki Institutes or alternative musical instruction. **A recording of a polished piece, Book 4 and above is required to apply for The Susan Bauman Memorial Scholarship.**
- The Margaret Poling Memorial Scholarship:** (piano) Margaret Poling was a wonderful Suzuki Piano teacher. In her memory, the Margaret Poling Memorial scholarship fund will be awarding a \$100 scholarship to a **piano** student attending the Idaho Suzuki Institute. It is a need-based scholarship with preference given to families with 3 or more Suzuki students attending Institute.
- The Gay Pool Piano Scholarship:** (piano) Gay Pool is a master teacher and an accomplished pianist who has inspired students for many years. Two \$200 scholarships will be awarded to piano students. Preference will be given to students who will not be able to attend the Idaho Suzuki Institute without financial assistance.
- June Itami Scholarships:** (any instrument) June Itami founded the Idaho Suzuki Institute in 1972 and began the tradition of annual music camps in Nampa. In her memory, donations made in her honor will be used to provide 1 string student a full tuition scholarship to attend Institute.
- ISA Scholarship:** (any instrument) The Idaho Suzuki Association will provide \$100 scholarships based on money available from donations and other fundraisers. The funds will be dispersed with the intention of helping cover a portion of tuition to the Idaho Suzuki Institute for as many students as possible.
- ISA First Timer Scholarships:** (any instrument) The Idaho Suzuki Association is offering \$100 scholarships to students who are attending Institute for the first time, both half-day and full day.

Families who are current members of, and whose teacher(s) are current members of, ISA, and who plan to attend the Idaho Suzuki Institute, should send the completed application by **April 15th**. Preference will be given to families who are actively involved in ISA activities. Applications postmarked after April 15 will not be considered. Scholarship recipients will be notified of awards given by April 25. Scholarship recipients must register and pay in full by May 5.
